



Trapping Instructions-

1. you need to have one trap per kitty you are trapping– it works best if you start 4 days prior to your clinic appointment
2. day 1 & 2 tie traps open - FEED IN TRAPS ONLY using soft food or tuna at the back of the trap, cover each one with a towel on top – it is ***very important*** you do this at the same time every day – dawn/dusk work best unless you have a set time the cats are already used to, keep that time & location the same if once exists, if not use a sheltered quiet spot away from activity
3. day 3 - leave traps open and covered in the same spot but DO NOT FEED the entire day
4. day 4 -this time untie traps and set following the below instructions – re cover the traps and be on the watch. Face the opening of the trap where you can see from a distance if its been closed & the cat is trapped – don't check the 1st 2 hours to give them time to investigate – and don't keep going to the traps, its best to check from afar
5. once a cat has been trapped remove it from the trapping site – keep it covered and move it to a garage or enclosed space without activity so they have very little stimulus – the exception to this is for mothers & kitten litters being trapped, whichever one you get 1st move the set traps so the back of the trap abuts the other cat and cover them together so the kitty seeks out its mom or kitten at the back of the trap – they are the best bait for each other.



Step # 1

Using one finger, push in near the top (AVOID all the tension wires, only place the finger on front gate as shown



Step # 3

Holding both gates open with left hand; use one finger of right hand and reaching INSIDE the trap place the trigger on the little gold roll bar. Note: some of our older traps do not have the roll bar-they will just catch on a gate wire. A good illustration from the top of the trap putting the trigger in place.



Step # 2

Pushing in on the front gate; use other hand and lift both gates using the finger loop at the bottom of the front gate.



Step # 4

Place about 1/3 can of soft cat food on the cardboard and place UNDER the trap at the fae rear. Cat must step on the trip plate to close the door.

Its Very important that the back be secured LOOP over LOOP and latched with the snap closure.
